

The historic, world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be visiting St. Mary of Vernon on Thursday, September 13th.

6:00 pm - Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament
7:00 pm - Vespers-Evening Prayer
7:30 pm - Final opportunity for veneration of
statue
8:00 pm - Closing Ceremony
